CONDITIONS

The Clark Collection Scholarship Attingham Summer School 1 - 19 July 2020

Important: the selection panel reserves the right NOT to select a candidate for the Attingham Summer School 2020. Their decision will be final and conclusive, and no correspondence will be entered into. No materials submitted will be returned.

CRITERIA

Preference will be given to candidates who:

- are in the middle stage of their career development with reasonable working experience in arts/built heritage/decorative arts
- show an ability or skill to make a significant contribution to the future development of built heritage/decorative arts in New Zealand
- would benefit from international exposure to leading art and heritage institutions and their specialist staff
- show a strong commitment to learning and skill enhancement
- could make a significant contribution to constructive debate during the Summer School.

ELIGIBILITY

Expressions of Interest are invited from individuals who are normally resident in New Zealand or are, for the time being, temporarily residing overseas but will return in the near future.

Interested individuals should be full-time employees of an organisation working in the heritage or museums sector.

Interested individuals should ensure that all/any necessary approvals (employer – leave of absence, visa if required, medical etc) are in place to allow attendance at the Attingham Summer School.

Interested individuals must show how they plan to cover the remainder of the costs associated with attendance at the Attingham Summer School.

APPLICATIONS

All Applications must be in the form as set out.

NOTIFICATION OF DECISION

The selection panel's decision will be advised as soon as possible after the closing date. Acceptance into the Summer School is decided by the Attingham Trust and cannot be guaranteed.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & REPORTING

The successful recipient will be required to acknowledge the assistance of the Clark Collection and Museums Aotearoa in any presentations or published reports. They will be required to submit a written report on their attendance at the Attingham Summer School within 3 months of its conclusion. Please note that the Attingham Summer School also requires a participant's report, which will form the basis of the report to the NZ supporters.
